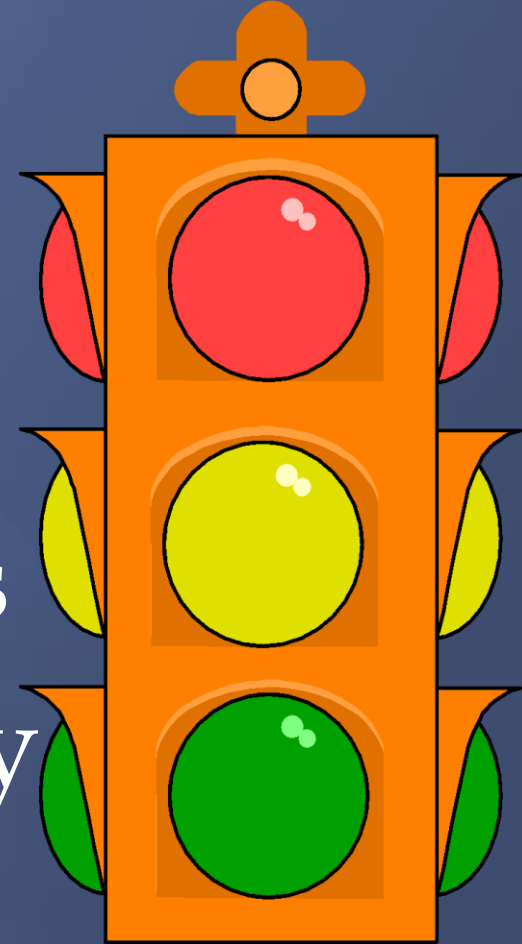
- ▣ The GOLDEN RULE:

BUS CONDUCT

- ▣ Same rules as the school
- ▣ Don't create distractions
- ▣ Bus drivers are authority
- ▣ Arrive on time



BUS CONDUCT

- ▣ Remain in seats
- ▣ NO PROFANITY
- ▣ Keep the buses clean
- ▣ BUS USE IS NOT A RIGHT
- ▣ KRHS is responsible for all students portal to portal



HALLWAY CONDUCT

- ▣ Give yourself time to travel
- ▣ Stay clear of RESTRICTED AREAS
 - B-wing is off limits to JH students
- ▣ Inappropriate displays of affection (IDA'S)

DRESS APPROPRIATELY

- ▣ Professional Environment
 - See through or midriff
 - Outdoor coats or overcoats
 - Undergarments showing: Too revealing
 - Offensive
 - Shorts... Can be worn all year round, however they must be appropriate.

INAPPROPRIATE

- ▣ No Hats & head scarves
- ▣ No hoods allowed up
- ▣ No Sunglasses
- ▣ No Outerwear(coats/ jackets)
- ▣ No CHAINS
- ▣ Anything deemed inappropriate by
ADMINISTRATION

Lunch

- ▣ Choose your seats
 - Once you decide you must add your name to the table list.
 - Possibility of switching seats but you must change the seating chart.
- ▣ Wait until called to lunch line
 - 3 sections are called up one at a time. (W, B, M)
 - Tables will rotate being called up.
- ▣ Students must be dismissed from lunch.
- ▣ Students cannot leave MPR until they are dismissed.
- ▣ Inappropriate behavior = Discipline

Lunch

- ▣ Please remember that you must clean up after yourself.
- ▣ Stack trays appropriately.
- ▣ The only doors we use entering the MPR are the main doors.
- ▣ Lunch Fund: There is a lunch fund in the JH Office. There is no borrowing of \$\$ from each other. If you need lunch \$\$ please come up to the JH Office and borrow from me.

Cell phones

- ▣ Cell phone usage:
 - Cell phones are allowed during the beginning and end of the day and during lunch.
 - HOWEVER...
 - You are not allowed to take pictures throughout the day.
 - It is not appropriate to use cell phones in bathrooms and/or locker rooms.
 - It is not appropriate to video tape classes or fellow peers.

HIB Definition

“Harassment, intimidation or bullying” means any gesture, any written, verbal or physical act, or electronic communication, whether it be a single incident or series of incidents that is responsibly perceived as being motivated either by any actual or perceived characteristic, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or mental, physical or sensory disability, or any other distinguishing characteristic, that takes place on...

HIB Definition Continued

school property, at any school-sponsored function, on a school bus, or off school grounds as provided in (18A:37-15.3) that substantially disrupts or interferes with the orderly operation of the school or the rights of other students and that:

- a. a reasonable person should know will physically or emotionally harm or damage
- b. has the effect of insulting or demeaning
- c. creates a hostile educational environment

Required Elements of a HIB

- ▣ Substantial disruption or interference with orderly operation of school
- ▣ Reasonably perceived as motivated by actual or perceived characteristic
- ▣ Physical or emotional harm to student
- ▣ Reasonable fear of harm to student
- ▣ Insulting or demeaning
- ▣ Created hostile educational environment

HIB: Harassment, Intimidation & Bullying

- Harassment
- Cyber bullying: Social Media
- Texting
- Name calling
- Consequences could become legal
- Think before you act
- HIB laws

HIB continued

- ▣ HIB reported...
 - Investigation must occur.
 - Students will be questioned.
 - Reports will be filled out.
 - HIB case will be reviewed by:
 - The Principal
 - The HIB team (Mrs. Falchetta, Mr. Black, and Mrs. Otto)
 - The HIB Climate & Safety Team
 - The Superintendent
 - The BOE
 - All investigated cases of HIB are reported on the SSDS (Student Safety Data System)
 - State reporting

SPECIALTIES

- ▣ Student concern reports:
 - Having problems-see your counselor (Mrs. Lasso) or me.
 - Report ALL incidents of harassment.
 - If you are unsure if this is a HIB case: Just stop by my office or Mrs. Lasso's and we will help you.

After school rules

- ▣ Students staying after for sports, tutoring, extra-curricular must have either a KRHS sticker or official pass
- ▣ If you do not have a pass you will NOT be permitted to board the 3:30 busses...

Staying after...

- ▣ If you are staying after with a teacher you must stay with that teacher from 2:15 – 3:20. The teacher you are with will give you a bus pass.
- ▣ You are only allowed to stay after if you have a purpose. You may not just stay after to hang out with your friends.

Detention

- ▣ 2:30-3:30
- ▣ Extended detention...2:30-5:30
- ▣ Remember the late bus stops are different from the 2:30 bus stops.
